The pupils who access our alternative provision have a variety of needs that range from EBD, ADHD, ASD and SEMH. These difficulties can manifest into extreme behaviours, so strong behaviour management and innovative techniques are necessary.

If you are passionate about inclusion and committed to achieving the best outcomes for all students, we are looking for two teachers to join our team. One to start as soon as possible and one to start in September 2018.
